

Discipleship Evangelism

Matthew 28:18-20 (NLT)

18 Jesus came and told his disciples, “I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth.

19 Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations*, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit.

20 Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.”

*The word “nations” means “all peoples.”

The Great Commission includes leading people to faith in Christ and making disciples.

The way revival and the next Great Awakening are going to happen in the United States is one person at a time.

Acts 2:38, 41, 46-47 (NKJV)

38 Then Peter said to them, “Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

41 Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them.

46 So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart,

47 Praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved.

Acts 4:4 (NKJV)

However, many of those who heard the word believed; and the number of the men came to be about five thousand.

Acts 5:14 (NKJV)

And believers were increasingly added to the Lord, multitudes of both men and women.

Acts 6:1, 7 (GNT)

1 Some time later, as the number of disciples kept growing...

7 And so the word of God continued to spread. The number of disciples in Jerusalem grew larger and larger, and a great number of priests accepted the faith.
