Logos and Rhema (See John 1:1, 14; Luke 4:4; John 14:26)

You can hear the voice of Jesus because Jesus is alive today!

Joel 2:28 (NKJV)

“And it shall come to pass afterward that I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your old men shall dream dreams, Your young men shall see visions.”

Acts 2:16-17 (NKJV)

16 But this is what was spoken by the prophet Joel:

17 “And it shall come to pass in the last days, says God, that I will pour out of My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your young men shall see visions, Your old men shall dream dreams.”

Prophecy

1 Corinthians 14:3 (AMP)

But [on the other hand] the one who prophesies speaks to people for edification [to promote their spiritual growth] and [speaks words of] encouragement [to uphold and advise them concerning the matters of God] and [speaks words of] consolation [to compassionately comfort them].

Dreams and Visions

Throughout the Bible God reveals Himself and His will through dreams and visions.

(See Genesis 15, 20, 28, 37, 41, 46; Numbers 12, 24; Judges 7; 1 Chronicles 17; 2 Chronicles 9, 32; Psalm 89:19; Isaiah 1; Ezekiel 11, 12, 13, 40; Daniel 1:17, 7:13, 8, 9, 10, 11; Obadiah 1:1; Habakkuk 2:2; Matthew 1, 2, 17:9; Luke 24:23; Acts 9, 10, 11, 16, 18, 26; 2 Corinthians 12:1; Revelation 1, 4, 9)

You can hear the voice of Jesus through prophecy, dreams, and visions.

Acts 1:17 (AMP)

And it shall come to pass in the last days, God declares, that I will pour out of My Spirit upon all mankind, and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy [telling forth the divine counsels] and your young men shall see visions (divinely granted appearances), and your old men shall dream [divinely suggested] dreams.
